

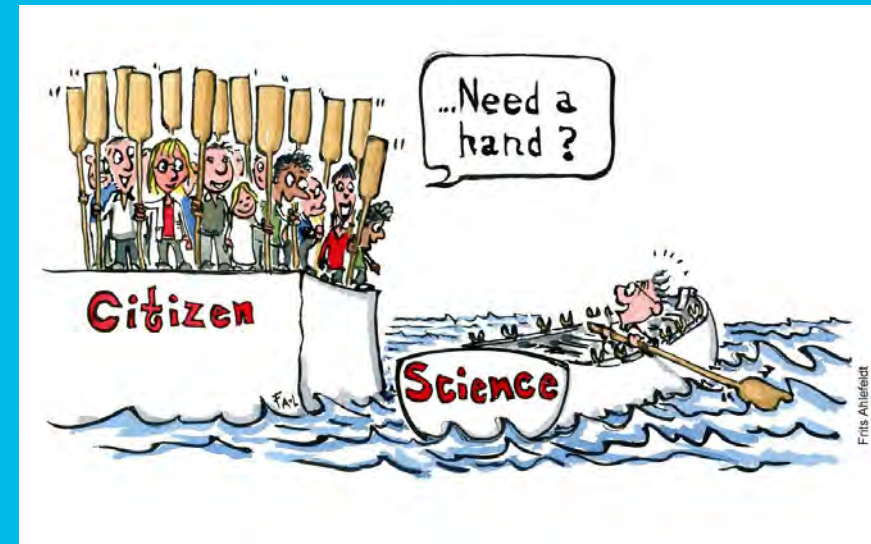

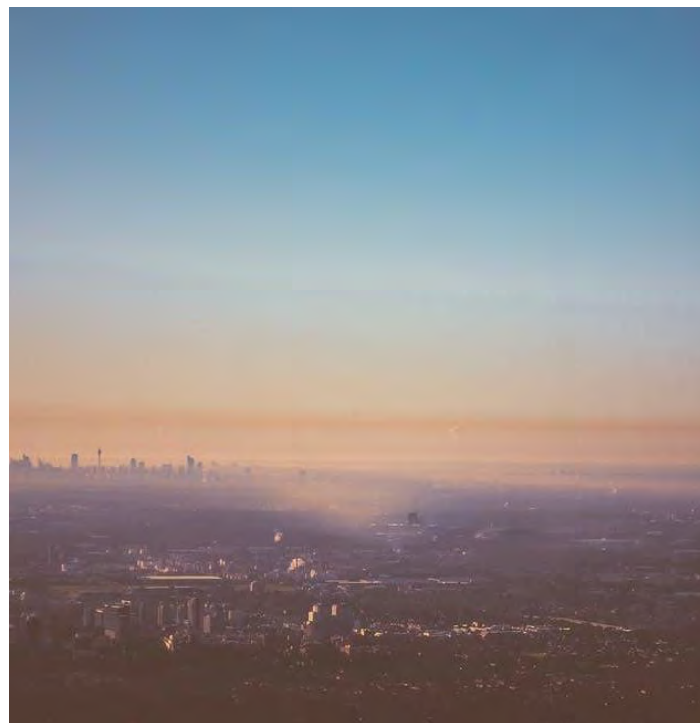
What is Citizen Science?

What is Citizen Science?

Citizen Science is **scientific research** conducted, in whole or in part, by **nonprofessional scientists** (citizens). Citizen science is **often** (but not always) conducted in collaboration with **professional** scientists.

Citizens conducting scientific actions

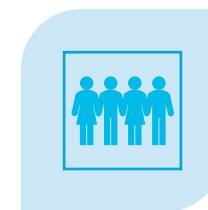

SOS Antwerp

- Death causes in Antwerp between 1820 and 1946
- 720 citizen scientists transcribe tens of thousands of records in 10 months
- You only need a computer and internet connection

I was convinced that you had to have a history degree to collect historical data. **The potential of such a motivated group is huge**, often they implement **better and more accurately** than our students.” *Isabelle Devos*
